# SCHEDULE & LEVEL OF SERVICE


- ◎ Marine Department comprised of two units
  - Marine Operations
  - Marine Maintenance
  
- ◎ Current total Marine Department full time staff is 67
  - 52 – Marine Operations
  - 15 – Marine Maintenance

# SCHEDULE & LEVEL OF SERVICE

- Currently consists of three (3) ferry crossings and one (1) maintenance facility
  - Chalmette to Lower Algiers
    - Operates Seven (7) days per week, 6:00 AM - 8:45 PM
  - Canal Street to Algiers Point
    - Operates Seven (7) days per week, 6:00 AM - 12:15 AM
  - Gretna to Canal Street
    - Operates Monday through Thursday, 6:30 AM - 5:30 PM; Friday, 6:30 AM - 11:00 PM; Saturday, 12:30 PM - 11:00 PM; Sunday, 10:30 AM - 5:30 PM

- Departures made every 15 minutes
- Primary Vessel: 66' W x 190' L, 858 gross tons, 60 vehicles, 870 passengers
- Services both vehicles and pedestrians
- 2011 ridership:
  - Pedestrian 9,230
  - Vehicle 479,174
  - Total 790,284

# SCHEDULE & LEVEL OF SERVICE

## CANAL STREET TO ALGIERS POINT

- Departures made every 15 minutes
- Primary Vessel: 54' W x 140' L, 566 gross tons, 50 vehicles, 692 passengers
- Services both vehicles and pedestrians
- The 2011 ridership:
  - Pedestrian 897,594
  - Vehicle 134,396
  - Total 1,116,659

## GRETNA TO CANAL STREET

- Departures made every 30 minutes
- Primary Vessel: 54' W x 142' L, 477 gross tons, 50 vehicles, 800 passengers
- Currently operates as pedestrian only, although can operate as a vehicle and pedestrian service
- 2011 ridership:
  - Pedestrian 81,640

# REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

- ⦿ Sets forth the terms of the Proposal submission process;
- ⦿ Informs the Proposers of “how to” submit Proposals;
  - Formatting; time, date, and location; etc.;
- ⦿ Lays out the evaluation factors;
- ⦿ Identifies the evaluation methodology;
- ⦿ Includes appendices with additional information
