The \$6.9 million La. 699 preservation project involves rehabilitating the base and doing an asphalt overlay on a 5.518-mile stretch of La. 699 from La. 35 to La. 343

With an average daily traffic count of approximately 2000 vehicles per day, La. 699 serves as a vital connection to U.S. 167, connecting motorists to enterprise, healthcare, higher education, and retail.

Since construction began in summer 2025, the contractor has conducted milling work, subgrade and base operations, installed side drain and cross drain pipe and performed drainage excavation at box culvert location, binder asphalt course operations, and milling asphalt pavement.

Currently the contractor is continuing soil cement operations, as well as the wearing course asphalt.

This project is estimated for completion in spring 2026.
